



Grant for Future ASL Teachers Scholarship Application Form to attend the Signing Naturally Introductory Workshop on June 18-19, 2010

Monetary Information:

Tuition = \$175

Materials = \$129.95

Stipend for Food and Lodging = \$125

Total scholarship per person = \$429.95

When your application is accepted, you will be required to pay a refundable **\$50 deposit and a 2 year membership (if you are not already a member) for a fee of **\$40** to WisASLTA by **April 30th**. Unless a check is received by the due date your place will not be reserved. Making a 2 year membership commitment demonstrates you are interested in continuing your professional training as an ASL teacher. Future workshops may also have scholarship opportunities. WisASLTA will provide you with a \$125 stipend in cash to assist with your food and your lodging during the training. The \$50 deposit will be reimbursed at the end of the last day of the training (Saturday, June 19).

NO EXCEPTIONS – if you miss any part of any day you will not get the \$125 stipend or your deposit back.

- 3) Ask a Deaf/HH nominator who uses ASL to provide you with a personal letter or vlog verifying your signing skills, saying how the training would benefit you and recommending you for the scholarship. Include this nomination with your application.
